Ride Over Gate Installation Instructions

NB. If installing for irrigator, ensure wheels run as much over the centre of the gate as possible.

- I. From vertical: Pull chains up to hooks and check pendulum action.

 Ensure rocker mechanism does not come into contact with dirt.
- 2. Build up dirt ramps either side so Gate Frame is supported once on the ground.
- Grease rocker mechanism at least once a month (depending on use).
 Separate Base Frame and gate frame by unhooking chains from latches on side of gate.
 Remove Gate Frame on about a 20° angle from vertical.
- 4. Put first post in the ground in desired position at normal height.
- 5. Bring ROG Base Frame flush with post and raise approx. 50mm off the ground. The easiest way to do this is to use some bits of 100×50 or 150×50 timber.
- 6. Line up second post flush with other side of Base Frame and ram or dig hole and sink post in.
- 7. Mark holes for drilling with 12-13mm auger (depending on how dry the posts are).
- 8. Drill holes. Lower Base Frame back, then put coach bolts in place.
- 9. Once bolts are tight, slide main gate frame into base frame at approx 20°.
